- Advancing donor and domestic resources mobilization and health budgets transparency and accountability to ensure that investments in health reach targeted communities and are aligned to strengthen primary health care services and universal health coverage for women, children and adolescents.
- Pushing for further inclusion of civil society and youth leaders in health policy and budget-making processes through adequate funding, technical assistance and coalition strengthening to hold country governments and other GFF stakeholders accountable.
